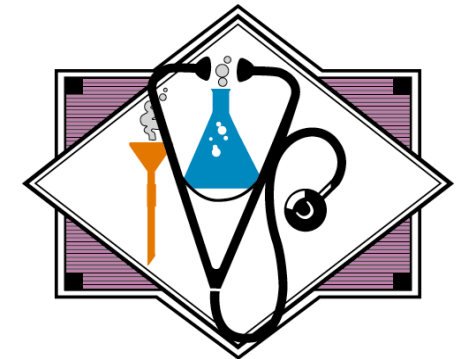

*The opportunity awaits you to hold a title and complete requirements for the State of Michigan Competency Evaluated Nursing Assistant (CENA) upon successful completion of the program. Utilize the skills learned at the Tuscola Technology Center in the rapidly expanding field of nursing and health care.*

## WHAT YOU WILL LEARN:

- ◆ Medical terminology
- ◆ Standard precautions/infection control
- ◆ Range of motion and lifting techniques
- ◆ CPR & first aid measures
- ◆ Vital Signs
- ◆ Transfers
- ◆ Nutrition/feeding
- ◆ Personal care

The second semester in this program includes a supervised work experience in a nursing home/long-term care facility with actual patient assignments. You will also be given work experiences in related health care career areas working with local professionals in the field.

Employment following this certification could be in a long-term care facility, extended care facility, nursing home, home care agency, hospital, clinic or physician's office.*
